

# PRIVACY POLICY

## 1. Personal Data Controller

UNIVERSAL CDN Inc., (referred to hereinbelow as “UCDN”, “we” or “us”) a company registered under the laws of the United States of America, having its registered office and address of management at 2777 North Stemmons Fwy., Suite 1555, Dallas, TX 75207, USA, operates this Website and the blog thereto and respectively is the personal data controller of the personal data provided by you via the contact and information forms, placed in the Website and the blog.

As far as UCDN offers its services, to a wide range of potential customers worldwide, including customers residing in or registered under the national legislation of member states of the European Union, UCDN is committed to guarantee its customers’ privacy and the protection of their personal data by adopting this Privacy Policy (referred to hereinafter below as “the Policy”). The Policy is in compliance with the applicable European personal data protection legislation, including but not limited to Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 April 2016 on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data, and repealing Directive 95/46/EC (hereinafter GDPR).

We will strive to do everything in our power to ensure your right to privacy. For us, the protection of your privacy during the processing of personal data and the security of all commercial data are important matters which we take into account in our business processes. We treat personal data collected when you use our Website and blog as confidential and process it solely in accordance with the statutory provisions of the applicable legislation.

## 3. Definitions

For the purposes of this Policy:

- “personal data” means any information relating to an identified or identifiable natural person (“data subject”); an identifiable natural person is one who can be identified, directly or indirectly, in particular by reference to an identifier such as a name, an identification number, location data, an online identifier or to one or more factors specific to the physical, physiological, genetic, mental, economic, cultural or social identity of that natural person;
- “processing” means any operation or set of operations which is performed on personal data or on sets of personal data, whether or not by automated means, such as collection, recording, organization, structuring, storage, adaptation or alteration, retrieval, consultation, use, disclosure by transmission, dissemination or otherwise making available, alignment or combination, restriction, erasure or destruction;
- “consent” of the data subject means any freely given, specific, informed and unambiguous indication of the data subject’s wishes by which he or she, by a statement or by a clear affirmative action, signifies agreement to the processing of personal data relating to him or her;

- “controller” means the natural or legal person, public authority, agency or other body which, alone or jointly with others, determines the purposes and means of the processing of personal data; where the purposes and means of such processing are determined by European Union or Member State law, the controller or the specific criteria for its nomination may be provided for by European Union or Member State law;
- “processor” means a natural or legal person, public authority, agency or other body which processes personal data on behalf of the controller;
- “third party” means a natural or legal person, public authority, agency or body other than the data subject, controller, processor and persons who, under the direct authority of the controller or processor, are authorized to process personal data; and
- “supervisory authority” means an independent public authority which is established by a Member State.

#### **4. Personal data we collect regarding you and legal basis for their processing**

The use of the Website does not require the provision of personal data on your part.

We collect, process and use personal data only if there is a legal basis for doing so, or if you have given your consent for your personal data to be processed for the stated purposes. We do not collect, process or use sensitive personal data of any kind.

The Website contains the following functionalities from which it is possible for UCDN to collect and process your personal data:

##### **4.1. Sending inquiries via “Contact us” contact form**

When you use the contact form for sending inquiries, UCDN collects and processes the following personal data for you, namely: **name, last name, e-mail address** and **any other personal data you have decided to provide us with in your inquiry**.

Your personal data are collected and processed:

- The legal basis for the processing of your personal data in this case is your explicit, voluntary consent, which we assume you gave, by sending us the inquiry.
- We can also use this data for direct marketing purposes to inform you about our services. In this case, the processing of your personal data is necessary for the purposes of the UCDN’s legitimate business interests from presenting and promoting its services.

##### **4.2. Use of registered account via “Login” button**

As a customer of UCDN you could register for an user account on the Website, via the “Login” button and consequently the provided registration feature. UCDN shall collect and process the following personal data for you, namely: **Username** and **E-mail address**. The username in question is chosen by you upon initial registration of your user account. As far as you are customer of UCDN your personal data shall be processed on the basis of the contract that you have with us.

##### **4.3. Use of cookies**

In order to function properly and at its full capacity, the Website uses cookies. For additional information regarding the used cookies and their specifics, please refer to the Cookies Policy.

## **5. Purposes for Processing**

We will use your personal data for the following purposes:

- For the purposes of sending a reply to the inquiry you have sent us.
- to administer your registered account if you choose to register and to provide the products and services you have requested from us;
- for customer management and replying to your enquiries to UCDN;
- for technical administration of the Website;
- to contact you with details of other services we provide.

## **6. Retention period**

UCDN will retain the personal data it processes for you for a term as long as necessary for the respective purpose of processing:

- For the personal data collect through the contact form - for the time necessary to prepare and send a reply to your inquiry and within 1 months of our last correspondence with you unless you become our customer in which case the relevant provisions of the Terms of Service or/ and the respective agreement signed between us shall apply regarding the processing of your personal data;
- For the purpose of sending you marketing communication for presenting and promoting our services - as long as you do not object to it or until you have unsubscribed from receiving such communication;
- For the purpose of your registration and creation of user account through “Login” button – as agreed in the agreement signed with us or in the Terms of Service, when they are applicable.

The above mentioned terms shall be applied as far as there are no longer terms provided by applicable legislation. ca

## **7. Non-Provision of Personal Data**

The provision of your personal data via the contact and information forms of the Website is entirely voluntary. In case you do not want to provide us your personal data, you will not be able to receive the desired services - we will not be able to reply to your inquiry or administer your registered user account on the Website.

## **8. Transfer of Personal Data to Third Parties**

We may provide your personal data to the following categories of recipients:

- affiliate entities, part of the UCDN group;
- state authorities, institutions and persons, to which we shall be obliged to transfer the personal data by virtue of the law;
- third parties, to which we assign different services – support of equipment, software and hardware used for the processing of the personal data, marketing services, programming, data hosting etc., and with which we have agreements for confidentiality and protection of personal data.

## **9. Rights of Data Subjects**

In connection with the processing of your personal data by UCDN you have the following rights:

**(a) right to access** – you have the right to confirmation as to whether or not UCDN processes your personal data and, where UCDN does, access to the personal data, together with certain additional information. That additional information includes details of the purposes of the processing, the categories of personal data concerned and the recipients of the personal data. Provided that the rights and freedoms of others are not affected, UCDN will provide you with a copy of its personal data. The first copy will be provided free of charge, but additional copies may be subject to a reasonable fee;

**(b) right to rectification** – you have the right to have any inaccurate personal data about you rectified and, taking into account the purposes of the processing, to have any incomplete personal data about you completed;

**(c) right to erasure** – you have the right to the erasure of its personal data without undue delay in the following circumstances: 1) the personal data are no longer necessary in relation to the purposes for which they were collected or otherwise processed; 2) you withdraw your consent to consent-based processing; 3) you object to the processing under certain rules of applicable data protection law; 4) the processing is for direct marketing purposes; and 5) the personal data have been unlawfully processed. However, there are exclusions of the right to erasure. The general exclusions include where processing is necessary: 1) for exercising the right of freedom of expression and information; 2) for compliance with a legal obligation; or 3) for the establishment, exercise or defense of legal claims;

**(d) right to restriction of the processing** – you have the right to restrict the processing of your personal data in the following circumstances: 1) you contest the accuracy of the personal data for duration of the necessary verification of the personal data; 2) the processing is unlawful but you oppose its erasure and requires its restriction; 3) UCDN no longer needs the personal data for the stated processing purposes, but you require the personal data for the establishment, exercise or defense of legal claims; and 4) you have objected to the processing, pending verification whether UCDN's legitimate interests have priority over yours. Where processing has been restricted on this basis, UCDN may continue to store your personal data. However, UCDN will only otherwise process it: 1) with your consent; 2) for the establishment, exercise or defense of legal claims; 3) for the protection of the rights of another natural or legal person; or 4) for reasons of important public interest;

**(e) right to objection to the processing** – you have the right to object to UCDN's processing of your personal data on grounds relating to your particular situation, but only to the extent that the legal basis for the processing is that the processing is necessary for one of the following: 1) the performance of a task carried out in the public interest or in the exercise of any official authority vested in Us; or 2) the purposes of the legitimate interests pursued by Us or by a third party. If you make such an objection, UCDN will cease to process your personal data unless We can demonstrate compelling legitimate grounds for the processing which have priority over your interests, rights and freedoms, or the processing is for the establishment, exercise or defense of legal claims;

**(f) right to data portability** – you have the right to receive your personal data from Us in a structured, commonly used and machine-readable format if the processing was based on your explicit consent or for the performance of a contract obligation and the processing is performed via automated means;

**(g) right to lodge a complaint with a supervisory authority** – if you consider that UCDN's processing of your personal data infringes data protection laws, you have a legal right to lodge a complaint with the supervisory authority

of one of the EU Member States, responsible for data protection. You may do so in the EU Member State of your habitual residence, your place of work or the place of the alleged infringement. **(h) right to withdraw the given consent** – to the extent that the legal basis for UCDN's processing of your personal data is consent, you have the right to withdraw that consent at any time. Such withdrawal will not affect the lawfulness of any processing performed before it. We shall do our best to reply to you without undue delay.

UCDN assumes no responsibility for the processing of such personal data by third parties.
